

## LIST OF SCHOOL MATERIALS 2022 - 2023

The items should be labelled with the student's name

### CP – CE1 (Grades 1 and 2)

- Whiteboard slate (A4 format maximum)
- Slate markers + slate duster
- 20cm ruler
- 45° set-square / triangle ruler (for 2nd grade students only)
- A kit comprising of a pencil, eraser, glue, pencil sharpener, round-tipped scissors, erasable pens (blue, red, green, black)
- 02 envelope folders for storing documents (plastic)
- A set of coloured pencils and felt pens



### CE2 (Grade 3)

- Whiteboard slate (A4 format maximum)

- 20cm ruler

- 3 highlighters of different colours

- Two A4 plastic folders (or flap folders)
- A pencil case with markers and coloured pencils
- Transparent paper to cover the books
- Self-adhesive labels to stick on the books covered for the school year

- A 30-cm rigid ruler (mandatory size)
- A set-square / triangle ruler and a protractor
- A good quality compass
- A calculator: i.e. Casio graph 35+ OR CASIO 92 OR TI College recommended
- A set of coloured pencils and felt pens
- A calendar or an diary
- A large folder + interleaves + 100 perforated plastic pockets  
=> Physics and Chemistry (for the 7th, 8th and 9th grade students)
- A packet of Bristol board paper

## **Art class supplies:**

- 1 HB pencil
