




## LIST OF SCHOOL MATERIALS 2025 – 2026

The items should be labelled with the student's name

### CP (Grade 1)

- Whiteboard slate (A4 format maximum)
- Slate markers + slate duster or eraser pad
- 20cm ruler in good condition 
- A kit comprising of a pencil, eraser, glue, pencil sharpener, round-tipped scissors, erasable pens (blue, red, green, black)
- Three highlighters in three different colors
- Three envelope folders for storing documents (plastic) in A4 format 
- A set of coloured pencils and felt pens

### CE1 (Grade 2)

- Whiteboard slate (A4 format maximum)
- Slate markers + pad or eraser
- 20cm ruler
- A set-square 
- A compass
- 4 highlighters – yellow, pink, green, blue
- A pencil case with two pencils, an eraser, glue, a pencil sharpener, scissors, erasable pens (blue, red, green, black) with cartridges. This material will be used throughout the year.
- A pouch with 12 felt-tip pens and 12 coloured pencils

- A spare pouch with 8 glue sticks, 3 pencils, 5 blue erasable pens, 3 green erasable pens, 3 red erasable pens and 5 slate markers
- Transparent paper to cover the books
- Self-adhesive labels to stick on the books covered for the school year
- Labels with the child's first and last name stuck on the material
- (Recommended) A French dictionary for 8-10-year-olds

#### CE2, CM1 (Grades 3, 4)

- 20cm ruler
- A set-square

- 3 highlighters of different colours
- A pencil case with two pencils, an eraser, glue, a pencil sharpener, scissors, erasable pens (blue, red, green, black) with cartridges.
- Two A4 plastic folders (or flap folders)
- A pencil case with markers and coloured pencils
- Transparent paper to cover the books
- Self-adhesive labels to stick on the books covered for the school year
- (Recommended) Labels with the child's first or last name stuck on the material.
- (Recommended) A French dictionary for 8-10 year olds
- A USB pen drive of 2GB or more

- A pencil case with two pencils, an eraser, glue, a pencil sharpener, scissors, erasable pens (blue, red, green, black) with cartridges.
- Two A4 plastic folders (or flap folders)
- A pencil case with markers and coloured pencils
- Transparent paper to cover the books.
- Self-adhesive labels to stick on the books covered for the school year
- (Recommended) Labels with the child's first and last name stuck on the material
- (Recommended) A French dictionary for 8-10 year olds
- (Recommended) A copy of 'La conjugaison' by Bescherelle publishers

- A 30-cm rigid ruler (mandatory size)
- A set-square / triangle ruler and a protractor
- A good quality compass
- A set of coloured pencils and felt pens
- A calendar or an diary
- From 6ème to 4ème (for 3ème refer to the to the high school calculator reference): A calculator: CASIO fx-92 special middle school classwiz or TI collège more recommended.
- A large folder + interleaves + 30 perforated plastic pockets  
=> Physics and Chemistry (for the 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grade students)
- A packet of Bristol board paper
- Mathematics: A large flexible ring-binder + 6 interleaves + 20 perforated plastic pockets

A CASIO Graph 35+E II graphing calculator recommended, or any other exam mode calculator equipped with the Python programming language if you already have one.

- Some fine felt-tip pens with pretty colours (eg: Stabilo pens)
- A large binder for Science class + 30 perforated plastic pockets

- A mechanical pencil (graphite leads) and eraser in good condition
